- ☀️ Miniatures must be 100 sq cm or less. For example: 10 x 10, 9 x 11, 8 x 12.5, 7 x 14 or 6 x 15 centimetres
- ☀️ Please note the Frame size must not exceed 30cm on any side.
- ☀️ SMALL WORKS are to be no larger than A4 size for the work and frames size must be kept to a reasonable proportion.
- ☀️ ANY TOPIC, ANY MEDIUM. SIZE is the ONLY LIMIT

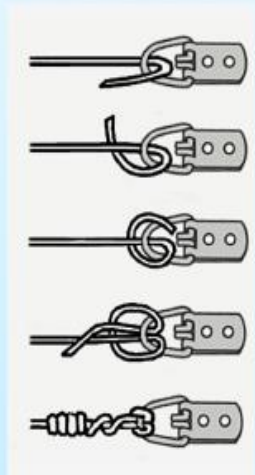

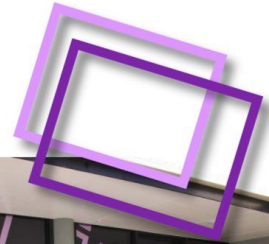
