



RULES FOR ARTWORKS IN THE MONTHLY COMPETITION SECTION

1:

- The entry fee is \$5 per painting. This must be paid when paintings are delivered. Entry fees are not refundable once a painting has been accepted for the exhibition. Paintings are to be delivered before 10.30am on the scheduled changeover day.
- Each member is limited to three (3) entries in each month's competition.
- An entry must not have received a 1st or 2nd prize at any other art exhibition.
- Each entry must be an original work of the artist submitting the artwork and be in keeping with the subject stated for the competition. Copies, photography, computer generated images are not acceptable unless a section is created for that type of art.
- Artworks cannot be entered into the same monthly themed exhibition in subsequent years.
- All entries must be for sale. The commission rate will be that applicable to each individual member at the time based on that individual's involvement.
- Artworks that are sold may be taken by the purchaser upon completion of payment and after the competition has been judged.
- Unsold artworks should not be collected before the next scheduled Exhibition without the Gallery Installation Co-ordinator's permission. Members may take their paintings out after 2pm, Thursday prior to the Friday exhibition and gallery changeover.
- Artworks are not to be left on Thursday afternoon to be entered on Friday morning, they must be presented by either yourself or your nominated person.

2. RULES FOR ARTWORKS IN GENERAL SECTION

- Members who volunteer at least once per month are entitled to install in the General Gallery. They may display around four (4) artworks, (but this will depend on the size of the artworks). If all are large then only three are permitted. If all artworks are small, then five are allowed. The installation team have the final say. As well as four small unframed paintings for the display shelves. The number may be reduced if there is insufficient space available.
- Artworks in the General Hanging area in the gallery can be displayed 4 times a year with a 3 month break in between.
- There is no restriction as to how old the painting is when it was completed for this section.
- If an artwork displayed in the General Volunteer's Hanging area of the gallery is sold, or the artist needs to take the artwork out for whatever reason, the artist may bring in another to replace it. Provided it is of similar size and type that would suit the position that the original painting was hanging. This is to avoid unnecessary work for the Gallery Installation Team. Do not hang artworks yourself. They should contact the Gallery Installation Officer, Ingrid Algie to arrange a suitable time to bring in their replacement painting on 0401 664 604.
