This is going to be a fun and informative 2 DAY workshop!

A hands-on pastel art workshop where we will cover the fundamentals of pastels, including how to use them. You will also learn various blending techniques and how to create depth and dimension in your art.

We'll discuss the unique properties of Clairfontaine Pastelmat, Colourfix Original and UART 600 paper and explore their differences in texture and how they affect blending and layering of pastels.

We will also explore underpaintings and when and how to use them.

During the workshop, there will be a live demonstration by the instructor and technique demonstrations as requested over the 2 days. Each participant will work on their own project, receiving guidance from the instructor as needed.

BYO LUNCH

Tea / Coffee will be available.

DAY 1

Day 1 of the workshop includes an introduction to the different types of pastels and their applications, a discussion on the unique properties of the chosen papers, and a demonstration. Students will then receive guidance while creating their own pastel artwork.

DAY 2

On Day 2, the session will begin with a brief recap of the previous day's techniques and a short demonstration. You will then have the rest of the day to continue working on your artwork with guidance.

MATERIALS LIST

PAPER: 2 sheets of paper Size A3 or similar:

SHEET 1. UART Original 600 *OR* ColourFix Original (white)

SHEET 2. CLAIRFONTAINE Pastelmat (white)

- Plus, some spare pastel paper for practicing techniques on.

Note: Pastelmat and Colourfix paper is available from THE WIDE BAY GALLERY, MARYBOROUGH.

I will have a limited supply of Uart 600 paper available for purchase \$6.00 (cash) per A3 sheet on the day if you would like to try it.

REFERENCE PHOTO: Clear photo with good contrast printed on high quality paper. Ensure you can see the details.

- Soft pastels and pastel pencils in colours suitable for your project.
- Blender/ shaper - preferably SOFFT brand (Pastelmat users only).
- Rubber blenders. Small soft Flat or angled shader brush.
- Selection of cheap soft brushes (including one flat)
- Water container
- Paper towel. 1 Cheap toilet roll. Old towel. Kneadable eraser. Cloth for cleaning your hands.
- Backing board suitable for size of paper and taping down.
- Masking tape.
- Glassine paper or something to protect your completed artwork for transportation.
- Easels will be provided for use at the workshop.
